

El Vicenç de la Mar

MAJORCA, SPAIN

El Vicenç de la Mar is an adults-only hotel in Majorca's beautiful bay, Cala Molins bay, just four miles from Pollença on the west side of Cap Formentor in Cala Sant Vicenç. Surrounded by azure waters at the foot of the Tramuntana mountains, guests here can catch the Mediterranean breeze while hiking, cycling or just relaxing on the beach.

Located on a crystal-clear cove, the hotel offers 35 beautifully appointed guest rooms. Certain rooms and suites have their own private terraces, while others feature private whirlpool baths or swimming pools. The Penthouse Suite offers a large terrace and private pool, Privilege Rooms have a shared swim-up pool, Junior Suites have private outdoor hot tubs and Signature Rooms have private terraces. The multi-tiered rooftop terrace offers a swimming pool, cocktail bar and restaurant where guests can enjoy the sweeping views across Cala Sant Vicenc.

Added features are a cosy Mediterranean-style library with activities like chess, backgammon and pool, as well as a 24-seater cinema. Chef Santi Taura, the recipient of two Repsol Suns and a Michelin Star at his sister restaurant DINS, heads up both of the hotel's gastronomic offerings at Restaurant El Vicenç and U Mayol.

When it's time to restore and refresh, guests can indulge in beauty enhancing and body revitalising treatments from prestigious brand Natura Bissé at the spa. A 42ft-long heated pool connects the indoor and outdoor area of the spa. The gym is open 24 hours a day and is equipped with the latest fitness technology.

Cap Formentor is one of the area's most popular and picturesque cycling routes, featuring a winding road that brings you to the lighthouse. It's a must for serious cyclists, with many professionals considering Majorca one of the best places to train in the winter.

Snorkelling and scuba diving are particularly popular, with many sunken ships waiting to be discovered. The area also has some extraordinary caves that date back to the Bronze Age, while mountain climbing has become very popular in the region.
