Declared a World Heritage Site in 2011, Mallorca's Cala Sant Vicenç drew an affluent and artistic crowd during its golden age in the 1950s- 60s. It is little wonder then that this destination, set at the foot of the Tramuntana mountains, is slowly regaining its spot as a luxury getaway. Leading this regeneration is El Vicenç, which channels the area's golden age to create a sophisticated, eclectic grandeur that's underlined by the surrounding natural beauty. The 30 rooms, four suites, and penthouse - some with outdoor Jacuzzis or pool - are awash in earthy shades and peppered by custom-made furniture with a twist. Opening in spring 2022, El Vicenç will also offer two unique gastronomic experiences led by Michelin star chef Santi Taura, widely regarded as one of the most talented chefs on the island.
